WINTERGREEN CEMETERY

Port Gibson, Claiborne County, Mississippi

Claiborne County, created 27 January 1802, and the opening of the Mississippi River following the completion of the Louisiana Purchase in 1803, brought about a land boom in the Mississippi Territory. Claiborne County was established fifteen years before statehood, and chose Gibson's Landing or Gibson's Port as the county seat. The name was officially changed to Port Gibson in 1811.

Thousands of settlers came from the eastern and northern states to claim the new lands. Most who came, stayed and lived out their lives in this area, and this became their final resting place.

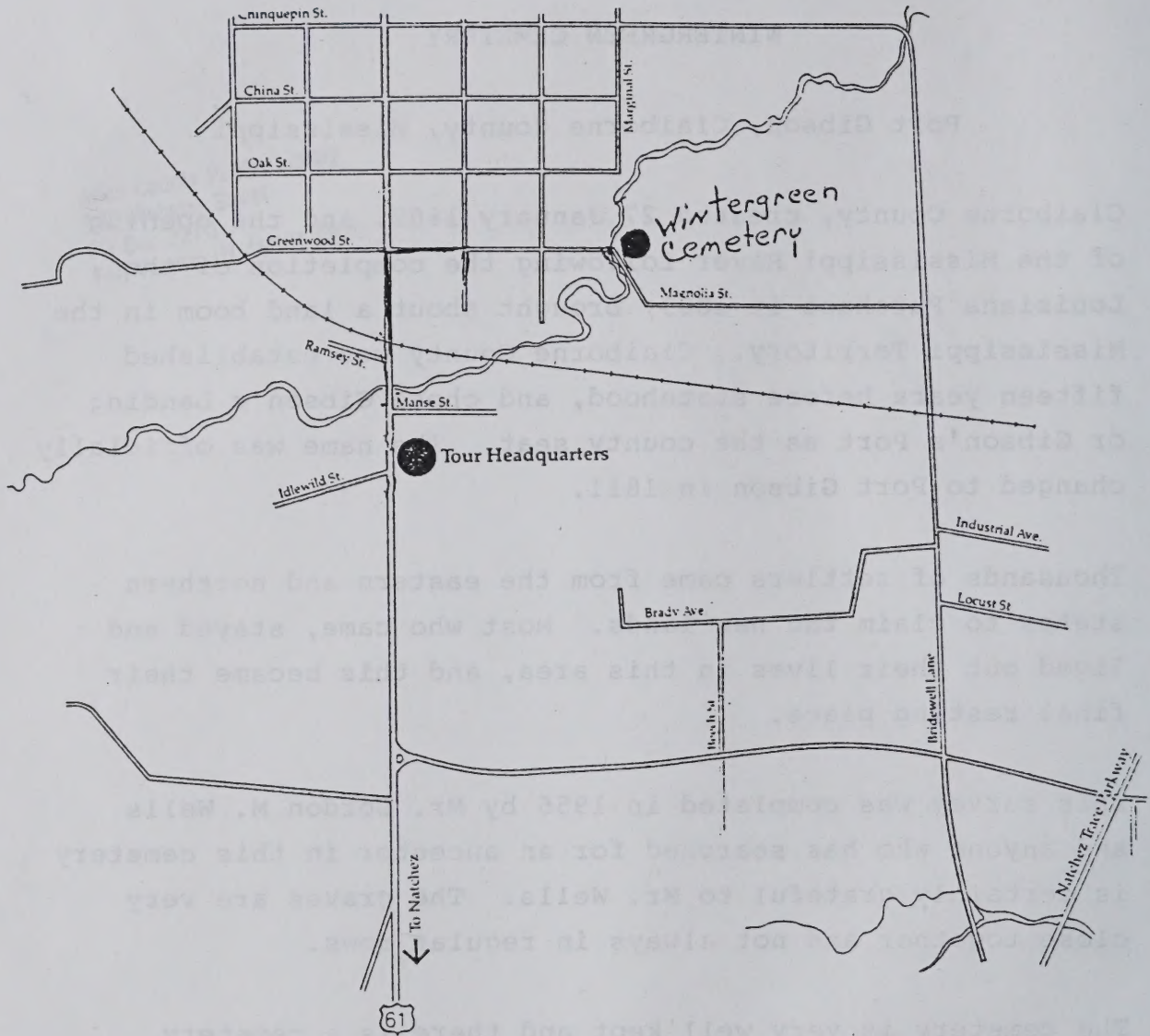
